[oscqam] Declining request 272218 for Ednilson Miura (emiura@suse.com). See Testreport: >SUSE:Maintenance:24247:272218/log

which should certainly be not some python internals but a proper URL

- **AC1:** Comments on smelt (from oscqam) show a reasonable URL again
