#### Description

Bug 743548 requests to enable WYSIWYG Editor through MediaWiki.

The wiki should have a WYSIWYG Editor.

tinyMCE can be enabled on MediaWiki. It can also be extended to offer templates.

The current editor features only a source code view, and a very limited markup support.

Typical editing requires multiple Preview-Edit cycles until the results come out as intended. E.g. I myself often need a few attempts to get link target and link labels in the right order with the right separator in between.
