<p>When I review qa_test_systemd failed in x86_64 and ppc64le(<a href="https://openqa.suse.de/tests/1190316">https://openqa.suse.de/tests/1190316</a>), I found it fails because of missing nfs package, which is in legacy module. (from screenlog in <a href="https://openqa.suse.de/tests/1190316/file/userspace_systemd-qaset.tar.bz2">https://openqa.suse.de/tests/1190316/file/userspace_systemd-qaset.tar.bz2</a>) Problem: nothing provides ntp needed by qa_test_systemd-1-31.1.x86_64 Solution 1: do not install qa_test_systemd-1-31.1.x86_64 Solution 2: break qa_test_systemd-1-31.1.x86_64 by ignoring some of its dependencies</p> <p>Here we can find nfs package <a href="http://10.160.0.100/install/SLP/SLE-15-Module-Legacy-Alpha5/x86_64/DVD1/x86_64/">http://10.160.0.100/install/SLP/SLE-15-Module-Legacy-Alpha5/x86_64/DVD1/x86_64/</a></p> <p>Shall we add Legacy module in HDD?</p>
