This is wrong to me because the system is already booted up.

openQA test in scenario sle-15-SP1-Installer-DVD-s390x-gnome@s390x-kvm-sle15 fails in <a href="#">reconnect_s390</a>

Fails since (at least) Build <a href="#">43.1</a> (current job)
