<p>In schedule/ext4.yaml, "installation/system_role" is conditional, depending on SYSTEM_ROLE, but the default value of SYSTEM_ROLE in sle12 is "default".</p> <p>I wonder if we should change the value of SYSTEM_ROLE in sle12sp5 or choose a different variable for the condition.</p> <p>I prefer the former solution, for example, set SYSTEM_ROLE=skip for testsuite in SLE12.</p> <p>openQA test in scenario sle-12-SP5-Desktop-DVD-x86_64-ext4@64bit fails in system_role</p>
