To prevent questions like in <https://openqa.opensuse.org/tests/961918> why a job is "cancelled" and shows no details I suggest to immediately show the #dependencies tab instead which can nicely visualize the reason

### Acceptance criteria

- **AC1:** A cancelled job with empty job details shows the #dependencies tab by default
- **AC2:** A failed or incomplete job with empty job details still shows the #details tab with the rendered autoinst-log.txt
- **AC3:** A job with job details still shows the #details tab by default
