Acceptance criteria

- **AC1:** The module sssd uploads logs on failure.
- **AC2:** The modules passes or soft-fail in a product bug.

Suggestions

For manual debugging, use root-console instead of serial console, then use developer mode to manually reproduce the issue and get logs.
