Description

- the [openQAtest] tag: searching for that tag would immediately return all packages we have automated tests for
- the name of the package in the title: that way we can query for individual packages
- the due_date field: this is the date when the test was completed and we started using it.

kernel-default would have other poos open for problems, bugs, issues in the existing test, extensions needed and so on. This poo would be Resolved as long as we actively run that test with our openQA tests, and would go back to Open or Rejected if we dropped it for any reason.
