<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. All the L3 binaries of the packages contained in the incident are installed and their version number has changed.2. All the L2 binaries of the packages contained in the incident are installed and their version number is ignored.3. New L2 and L3 binaries are installed after applying the update. The status of unsupported binaries is logged, but does not affect test failure or success. L2, L3 and unsupported are levels as exist in the SUSE:Channels.			
This does not change the way an update is installed.

The version check part of the ticket was completed. As part of that, I added a softfail where updates were installed but not for all packages in the update as reported by SMELT/IBS. This is expected as the install test has limited to no dependency resolution. Eventually dependency resolution will be added and I assumed this record of softfailures would fail.

I think that the ticket should move to being resolved, unless you disagree with the soft-failure.
