Description

Observation

The command
#echo \$SSH_TTY | grep "\dev\pts\
is returning the expected result but the system sends a failure message :
"-bash /dev/sshdserial: Permission denied"
This happens only with the particular architecture.

Investigate if this is an infrastructure issue or a Bug and open the relative tickets.

openQA test in scenario sle-15-SP3-Online-ppc64le-minimal+role_minimal@ppc64le-hmc-4disk fails in [sshd](#)

Test suite description

Like default but explicitly select the system role "minimal". The resulting system should roughly correspond to an unregistered system but with access to modules for optional installation.
