The test first deselected all packages in PACKAGES which are prefixed with - by pressing -. For aarch64 that includes grub2-arm64-efi, but pressing - there doesn't do anything. This is probably because it's a hard dependency of something else and YaST doesn't allow breaking them that way. The x86\_64 test uses grub2 instead, which isn't installed by a hard dependency there. I tried using grub2 on aarch64 as well, but there shim requires it because it was booted with EFI. Deselecting both shim and grub2-arm64-efi or just shim works in this case.
